- May: Possibility / Ask permission politely
 e.g. Noise pollution may cause headache and make people nervous.
 May I borrow your book?
- Must / Have to / Has to / Need to : Obligation
 e.g. Why do we have to keep the bottles and cans?
 We need to bring our own shopping bags.
- Should : Advice
 e.g. We should avoid using plastic bags.
- Shall: Suggestione.g. Shall we pack those things now?
- Will: Prediction
 e.g. People will collect the bottles and cans for recycling.
