This is not the first movie of the Ice Age **series**. This interesting series, which **achieved unprecedented** success, has gained popularity among children and youngsters in all parts of the world. There are three main characters: Manfred, a woolly mammoth, Diego, a tiger, and Sid, a sloth. Ice Age 1 and 2 focus on the friendship among the three different animals. Manfred, who thought he was the last woolly mammoth in the world, met his Ms Right, Ellie, and formed his own family.

In this episode, Ellie and Manfred are expecting their new baby. Manfred is a very **nervous** father who starts building a playground before the baby is ready to be born. This playground is **unfortunately** damaged by Sid, who has **adopted** and is **attempting** to raise three dinosaurs. At the same time, Diego decides to leave the team because he can't catch his prey. It seems that the team is going to be **disbanded**. However, Sid is caught in a mysterious

jungle, which is under thick ice, by the dinosaurs' mother. In order to rescue Sid, the other characters together begin an adventure, coming across dangerous plants, cruel dinosaurs and **fatal** smoke.

As in the last two episodes, the characters are amusing, especially the squirrel, Squat, who tries his best to get the acorn. The plot is exciting and surprising. You will never know what is going to happen unless you watch till the end. You also have to have tissues ready because you will definitely feel **touched**. All in all, if you want a film to help you fall asleep, you will be disappointed!
