## Plurals

## Language focus

Many nouns are countable nouns．We can count them．Countable nouns have two forms： singular and plural．
－We use a singular noun to talk about one person，animal，thing or place．
e．g．I have a cat．
We use a plural noun to talk about more than one person，animal，thing or place． e．g．I have two cats．
