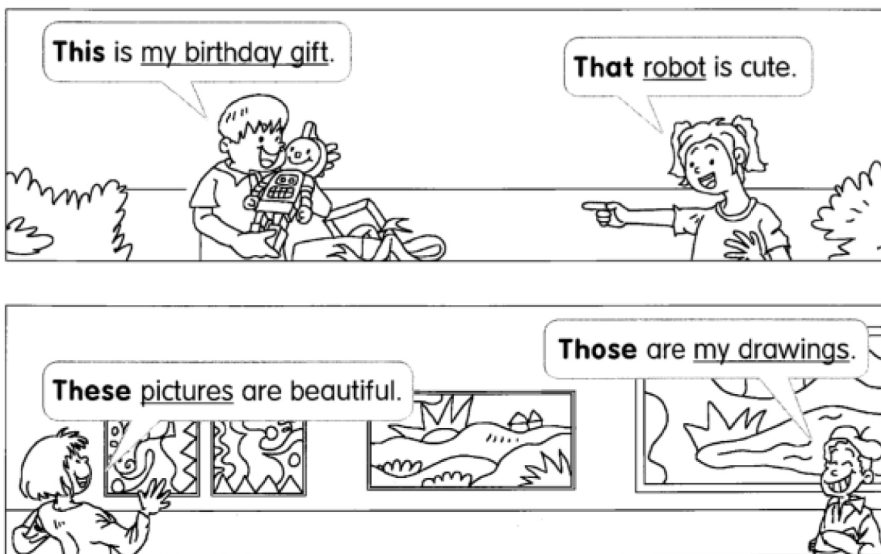


Demonstrative Pronouns
